



PEI New Product Development Award

PEI practice division is participating in the NSPE “New Product Development Award” program for nominations of exemplary new products that demonstrate the innovative use of engineering principles and provide overall benefit to society.

Entries are judged based on a product’s sales and economic impact, innovative use of engineering principles and improved function. Nominations are grouped according to size of the industrial company and winners may be selected in four categories: small, medium, large, and mega.

To be eligible, each submission must be for a product, machine, process, or material that has been developed in the United States and first placed on the market between 2001 and 2005. Entries should be submitted and received NYSSPE headquarters no later than March 30, 2006. Winners will be entered in the 2007 national competition. The award at the state level is a plaque.
